

Taawon Internship Program

For Future leaders in the Service of the Palestinian People

Taawon, as a leading non-governmental Palestinian development organization, is committed to building a diverse pool of future leaders who strive to make a distinguished contribution toward furthering the progress of Palestinians, preserving their heritage and identity, supporting their living culture, and building civil society.

What are the objectives?

- Provide a framework to engage young graduates of Palestinian origin from anywhere in the world with the work of Taawon, where their educational experience and relationship to Palestine can be deepened through practical development opportunities.
- Provide an opportunity for Taawon area teams to benefit from the engagement of Palestinian graduates specialized in various fields related to programmatic and administrative activities of Taawon.

About the internships and practical arrangements

- Taawon offers internships in program areas and in administrative areas such as, HR & Administration, fundraising, digital transformation, and institutional relations.
- Selected Interns will sign a 'traineeship contract' with Taawon and will receive a certificate of completion at the end of the period.
- Start and end dates for each group intake are fixed. Fall semester (Sept to Dec), Spring Semester (Feb to May). On average, the duration of the internship is about 14 weeks.
- The internship program commences with group orientation and ends with group debriefing and presentation of achievements and projects.
- Interns will be offered a monthly meal, communication, and transport allowance of 300 USD.

• Interns joining from abroad will need to arrange their own entry and residency visas. Taawon does not offer travel and accommodation expenses; however, will assist in identify potential grants for this purpose.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Anyone of Palestinian origin over the age of 20 and under the age of 25
- Completed an undergraduate degree at minimum in any field of study. Those enrolled in a master program that requires practical experience can apply and use the internship for this purpose.
- You are fluent in Arabic and /or English
